

Shenendehowa Special Education Summer Programs 2011

Dates: July 4 – August 12 (no class July 4th)

Location: K-5 Arongen Elementary, 6-12 HS East

Academic Skills Development – ASD (half-day program)

This program is designed to prevent significant regression over the summer in the areas of math, reading and writing. Each classroom will be staffed with a certified special education teacher and a shared program aide. Assessment must be completed to show regression over breaks and inability to recover skills after re-teaching for a period equal to the break. Multi-sensory reading programs will be provided for qualified students.

2 ½ hours per day

Ratio: 15:1

Behavioral-Emotional Skills Development – BESD (full day program)

This program is designed to prevent significant regression for students with emotional, behavioral and social disorders. Structured lessons in language, reading, writing and math will be included in the program to reinforce already learned skills. Weekly field trips may be incorporated into the program. Each classroom will be staffed with a certified special education teacher and at least two program aides. Related services will be provided if the student demonstrates significant regression as measured throughout the school year.

5 ½ hours per day

Ratio: 12:1:2

Functional Skills Development – FSD (full day program)

This program is designed to prevent significant regression for students with cognitive, communication, and adaptive deficits. Academic (reading, writing, math), language, and social activities will be provided throughout the day to reinforce previously learned skills. Weekly field trips may also be included to reinforce the themes. Each classroom will be staffed with a certified special education teacher and one program aide for every four students. Related services will be provided if the student demonstrates significant regression as measured throughout the school year.

5 ½ hours per day

Ratio: 12:1+(4)
